

Uganda More 'Budget' itinerary:

Day 1: Kampala, Pre-departure

Today will be our chance to prepare for the exciting adventure ahead. We will meet after lunch at Red Chilli Hideaway – a relaxing lodge a short 10-minutes from Uganda's Capital city, Kampala. Here, we will have a chance to meet our fellow travellers and chat about the trip ahead before heading into town do shopping and exchange money before leaving civilisation for the following 2 weeks.

After an early start to avoid the Kampala traffic, we will begin our journey southward to Lake Mburo National Park. Enjoy the comfort while you can! We will arrive at our campsite on the lake in time for lunch before heading on an evening game drive – our first chance to find some African wildlife.

habitat; a humbling and life changing experience

We will drive through Fort Portal – a town nestled in the middle of the magnificent Ruwenzori Mountains, Africa's 3rd highest mountain range, and home to the lush Kibale Forest, most famous for its chimpanzee populations in Africa. Here is where we will spend the next 2 nights enjoying the incredible birdlife and scenery, in addition to our unforgettable chimp trekking experience.

Day 11: Kibale to Murchison Falls National Park

This morning kicks off with an early start and a long drive on some real 'Ugandan' roads, so enjoy the ride!

We head to one of our personal favourites, and one of Africa's most prestigious

National Parks, Murchison Falls.

Murchison Falls itself is one of the most powerful surges of water in the world, where the mighty Nile River is pushed through a 6m-wide gap, creating a powerful explosion of water right in front of your eyes. Falls aside, the massive, green, open plains of this National Park are home to a huge variety of wildlife, including breeding herds of elephant, journey upon journey of the endemic 3-horned giraffe, a great population of lion, and much, much more. This is truly mesmerising experience.

Our time here will be spent camping wild in the middle of Murchison Delta.

Once our cruise is complete, we begin the short journey to Ziwa Rhino Sanctuary – not before stopping at the Murchison Falls View point, where we will see the massive explosion of water of this powerful waterfall.

Ziwa is a private organisation in Uganda devoted to bringing the 5th member of the Big 5 back into wild Uganda. We will arrive by mid-afternoon and enjoy the rest of the day at leisure
